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Weekly Curriculum Guide

Math:

We will complete our unit on money and take our test on Wednesday.

This Thursday we will take a subtraction timed test and will keep our time to 7 minutes. Remember, our goal is 80% accuracy within 6 minutes by the end of the year.

Foundations: We will begin unit 11, week 1. We will learn about the double vowels for the long e sound – ee, ea, ey.

Trick words: whose, won, son (students need to memorize these words)
