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Weekly Curriculum Guide

Math:

We will begin our unit on graphs. We will learn about taking surveys and reading and analyzing picture graphs.

For the next 2 weeks, everyone will be taking addition and subtraction timed tests. I want to be sure we remember those facts. We will go back to multiplication and division for those that are on those facts the week of the 23^{rd} .

Reading: We will be reading "How the Beatle Got Her Colors". We will focus on theme of a story as we read folktales.

In Language we will learn about the irregular verbs of come, run, hide, give, sing and sit.

Fundations: We will learn about the ee, ea and ey vowel teams in multisyllabic words (as in chimney and teacher).
