## Weekly Curriculum Guide

## Math:

We will be learning about fact families and finishing up unit 1. Our $1^{\text {st }}$ math test will be on Tuesday, October1st. I will be sending home study materials on Friday.

We will take our $1^{\text {st }}$ subtraction timed test this Thursday, September 26th. The students will have 10 minutes to complete 100 problems.

## Social Studies:

Students will learn about seasons and climate. We will also practice reading a table.

Vocabulary Words: climate

## Language Arts:

In Reading we will read "Finding

Cal". We will continue to focus on character, setting and events in a story. We will begin using context clues to figure out meanings of unknown words.

Vocabulary: decide, different, friendship, glance, proper, relationship, stares, trade

In Language we will be learning about subjects of sentences as well as the format of a friendly letter - greeting and closing.

In Fundations we will review the bonus letter rule with the letters ff , 11 , and ss.
