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Weekly Curriculum Guide

Math:

We will complete unit 1 and take our math test on Tuesday. We will then introduce unit 2 – Number Patterns.

We will take our next addition timed test on Thursday. The students will have 10 minutes to complete 100 problems.

Social Studies:

Students will learn about finding directions on a map.

Vocabulary: equator, cardinal directions, hemisphere, pole

Language Arts:

In Reading we will learn about finding key details in a story by using photos. We will also learn more about root words.

Vocabulary words: allowed, care, excited, needs, roam, safe, wandered, wild

In Language we will learn about the predicates of sentences as well as the suffixes of –ed and –ing. We will also learn about putting commas in sentences when sequencing.

In Foundations we will review the glued sounds of – am, an, ang, ong, ank, onk, ing, ung, ink, and unk. They receive 1 tap with three fingers.

Trick words: both, talk and walk (students need to memorize these words)

Read 20 minutes nightly
